I desire to get my little pet Hunting Box my under bed and Blanket I give to Patsy Teaser and for every thing else I give whatsoever of all & every sort & kind of Moveable property or Household furniture to me belonging I Bequeath I give to my son Robert Caldwell, but my sons Robert & James Caldwell are to discharge & Equally in or about Twenty Shillings I owe at this time or to the amt of one Dollar more if requisite. But as for my son Robert Caldwell him I name but him I do hereby constitute & appoint the sole executor of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby utterly revoke disallow & disannul all former bequests will & legacies by me hereunto in any wise left or made, Declaring Ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 24th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
