 born in the Year 1769 Apprentice to William Beattie
 to serve him or his assigns from the day of the date hereof untill
 he arrives to the age of Twenty one Years during which time
 his said Master he shall faithfully serve and Lawfull
 Commands obey & s.^d Wm Beattie for him self his heirs
 and assigns in Consideration thereof doth hereby Covenant
 promise and agree with the said Ann Campbell and John
 Campbell that he the said William Beattie during
 the s.^d time shall Learn or Cause to be Learned to the
 said ~~John Sharp~~ s.^d John Sharp the Trade & mystery of Wheel
 right & will at his proper Costs and Charges provide
 and allow him the s.^d John Sharp sufficient meet Drink
 aperial and Lodging and all other Necessaries fit and
 convenient for such an apprentice According to the Laws
 and customs of this Commonwealth and also shall and will teach him
 to read write and Arithmatick as the Law requires in like Cases
 & witness whereof the said parties have hereunto subscribed their Names
