I do betroth and give to my beloved and only begotten & child
Elizabeth Cane one gray Racing mare. I also betroth and give unto my
Beloved and only begotten child Mary Edwards the Sorral Mare and
the two year old horse and to Joseph Edwards my only begotten child I do
betroth and give the Bigg Gray trotting mare and to John Edwards my
only begotten son the old Mare three year old I do betroth and give
to Abigail Edwards my only begotten Daughter the Bigg trotting mare
two year old mare and the cow that I bought of the Bryants Estate
And thirty two Pounds in cash in the house to go to cloth the two
youngest boys and the Big Bay horse to be sold the seat fall ad
the money to go to schooling the said two youngest boys
And I do hereby appoint Zepe Cane Executor for the Children
till they come of age Mary Edwards Joseph Edwards and John Edwards
and their Estates to come to them when they come of age from
the said Zepe Cane as above mentioned and there inresp also

I Robert Gilliespy of Washington County being sick and weak
of body but of a sound disposing memory thanks be to God for his
Mercy and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die Do make this
my Last will and Testament first I give my soul in Charge to God who give it a
being in hopes of his mercy all the Resurrection and my Body to be Buried in such
Decent manner as my Executors shall think proper and as to my worldly
Goods I leave in the manner following First I order all my lawfull Debts to be
Paid first I will and bequith unto my Children my Plantation and my Smith
Tools and my Riffle Gun item I will and bequith unto my wife my well befo
Wife one horse and saddle and one tegise boy called Ben during her lifetime
and then to be sold and Equally Divided to my Children and the Remaining
Effects I order to be Equally Divided between my wife and Children all where
I appoint and ordain William Gilmore and Charles Hoag to the Executors of said
Will in Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal this twentieth day
of June 1778
