this my last Will and Testament, that is to say Principally and First of all I give & recommend my soul
into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in a decent
Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God. And touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this
Life, I give Devise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form

Thus I do give and bequeath to Wmth Windham my dear beloved Wife, I leave her two of my Coats and
in choice of my Arms & Jewels belonging therunto, and my powder of my young black horse, with the best of large Iron
Pots. I also leave her my house Bible during her life and then to descend to my Son Joseph Windham. My
Plantation & plantation tools of every sort, with my Coesent and I leave to my Grand Son (My Son John's Son)
David Windham, and he is to take care of and maintain his Grandmother while she lives. — My 200 Acres
Land on Long Neck I leave to David Simson. I leave our red cow to my Grandson David Windham (Son
John's Son) — My young Gun I leave to Stephen Windham with my rifle Gun — My 200 Acres of
Land at the Hunters Ford I leave to David Windham (Joseph's Son) after my lawful debts is payed I
leave the other part of my Estate to the whole disposal of my Son John Windham, that is to say, to be disposed of
among himself, his Children and Elizabeth Windham and my Son Burrows two Children, that is my Grand
Son David Windham & his Sister Phoebe Windham. — My ready Money I leave to be divided between my
Daughters Elizabeth & Son Burrows two Children David Windham & Phoebe, that is I leave the one half to
my Daughter and the other half to be equally divided between the other two — My Son John Windham
whom I likewise have constituted make & appoint the sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and it is
herby swallow and receive all & every other former Testaments Wills & Legacies by me in anywise before
named called bequeathed. And confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 25th Day of January 1779 — Signed sealed published and
delivered by the said David Windham as his last Will & Testament in the presence of us who in his presence & in the
