28th 1794 I David Macwell of the county of Washington and
State of Virginia being very sick and weak of body but of sound mind
and perfect memory thanks to God, therefore and knowing my mortality
that it is appointed for men once to die and after death the judgment
I do make this my Last Will and Testament Primarily, and first
of all I commend my soul to God who gave it and my body to the
earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my
executors nothing doubting but I shall receive it at the general
resurrection again by the mighty power of God, and as for
what worldly estates it hath pleased God to vouchsafe me with
in this life I bequeath and dispose of in the following manner
viz 1st I Order and Ordain that all my lawful debts be
paid out of my movable estate, 2nd I leave and bequeath to
my well beloved wife Elisabeth three cows and all the household
furniture untill here, and to have here living on the plantation
untill here death, 3rd I leave and bequeath to my son
James one round year old colt past last spring and the plantation
in him paying Walkers demands for the plantation whereon I
now live with all improvements and appurtenances to him and his
heirs and assigns forever. 4th I Order my movable estate to be
publicly sold after my wifes death, and the money equally
divided between all my children
