Now know ye, that I, for the consideration of Five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Michael Montgomery of Washington County have granted, bargained and sold to the said Michael Montgomery his heirs, Admin^{ors} or assigns the exclusive right of making, con-constructing, using and vending to others, to be used the said Patent Stills in the Counties of Washington, Lee, Russell, Fauverell, and Grayson in the State of Virginia, and Sullivan County in the State of Tennessee, And I, the said Edward Richardson, do further agree to let all improvements made, or that may be made hereafter by me on Stills, go to the benefit of the said Michael Montgomery's heirs and assigns. As Witness my hand & seal this sixteenth day of November in the year eighteen hundred and seven.
