

(93) Be it known that I do hereby emancipate and set free forever, Fincas
the Sterrett commonly called Fin a Mulatto Man about thirty
years of Age - lately the property of William King Decar^d and
purchased by me when sold under Execution from the
Federal Court for District of Virginia - And to this
Act I am induced by my high sense of his merits
as a man of probity &c.
In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 21st
Day of Novem^r 1811.
