I Francis Kincannon being weak and sickly of body, the of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will & Testament in manner following viz. 1st I commit my soul to God and my body to their dust to be after death there buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors — my worldly Estate I will & bequeath as follows, I leave & bequeath to my well beloved wife Elizabeth Kincannon all my moveable property and one third of my plantation and my dwelling house saving her natural life — I leave and bequeath to my son James Kincannon five pounds — I leave and bequeath to my son Andrew Kincannon five pounds — I leave and bequeath to my daughter Mary Smith fifty pounds — I leave and bequeath to my son Francis Kincannon twenty pounds — I leave and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Porterfield fifty pounds — I leave and bequeath to my Grand daughter Betty Scott thirty pounds I will and bequeath to my son George Kincannon all the plantation in which he now dwells, he is paying to Mary Smith & Elizabeth Porterfield the above Legacies to them named within the time hereafter specified — I will and bequeath to my son Matthew Kincannon all the plantation on which he now dwells he is paying to James Kincannon (now deceased) Kincannon and Francis Kincannon and Betty Scott the sums by me above bequeathed and fifty pounds to be equally divided between James and Francis Kincannon also all my Debts and funeral charges — I will and ensure that the above legacies by me bequeathed be paid as I have directed, within the term of five years after my Decease — And I hereby appoint James Kincannon and John Stewart Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 10th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five.
