I Elizabeth Henry of Washington County Virginia Wife of Samuel Henry Decd. being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to god calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing it is appointed for all one to die Do make & ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that give it & my Body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent christian manner at the discretion of my executors and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give demise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form First I give & bequeath to my son & son in law James Henry & Hugh Megill the price of my Negro woman named Fawn when sold to be equally divided between them also I give to James Henry my son & my other son in law William Megill the Bonds that I have against John Kincaid of Kentucky the father of Robert Kincaid of Washington County Virginia
