for the same And being desirous to settle all my worldly
affairs before I depart this life do therefore publish
pronounce and declare these presents to be my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following
(to wit) First it is my will and desire and I do
humbly order and direct that all my legal and just
debts shall be fully satisfied and paid off as soon
as may be after my decease And all my estate both
real and personal then remaining I give and
bequeath unto my dear wife Christiana during her
natural life to be applied and disposed of as she
may think proper, and after her decease I give
and bequeath unto my daughter Hannah wife of
John Hamblton living in Kentucky the sum of
one Spanish milled dollar to be paid to her out of
my estate in full for her share of my said estate
I also give and bequeath unto my son George
Stofe the sum of one Spanish milled dollar to be
paid to him out of my estate the same to be in full
for his share And all the residue and remaining
part of my estate Real and personal be the same of
what kind or nature soever I give and bequeath
to be equally divided between all the remaining
part of my Children and Grand Children not yet
before named viz^t to each of my sons Henry, Jacob,
Abraham, and Isaac one equal share & to George
Hamblton and to Elizabeth Hamblton heirs of my daughter
Christiana Hamblton deceased jointly one equal
share and to the lawful heirs of my daughter
Catherine Miller one equal share of my real and
personal estate aforesaid And lastly I constitute
and appoint my beloved wife Christiana sole
Executor of this my last Will and Testament
humbly moving and making void all former Wills

Know all men by these presents that I Flan Ward of the County of Washington for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto George Shelly of Washington County all and singular the goods and chattels herein after mentioned to wit two Cows and Pairs one feather bed and one Chaff, and furniture, two Trunks and Boxes, fourteen head of hogs, one steer five hundred feet of planks, one walnut Table, one pair of washing bars Box 2 blankets four Coverlets, six painted plates four pails and two Tubs - Also one iron pot, Kettle and Skillet and one hundred weight of flax and twelve pounds of Cotton To have and to hold all and singular the said goods and chattels to him the said George Shelly and to his heirs and assigns and to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof forever as his and their own proper goods and chattels And I the said Flan Ward for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators do covenant with the said George Shelly and his execs and admin that I the said Flan at the sealing and delivery of these presents have full power to grant and sell the said goods and chattels hereby granted, and that the said George Shelly his exec &c at all times hereafter have full power and authority lawfully to enjoy the said goods
