Know all Men by these presents that I John Cope of the County of Washington & Commonwealth of Virginia for Divers good Causes and Considerations in Lawfully moving have made ordered concluded and affirmed and by these presents do make, order, conclude, & affirm my truly friend Jacob Cope of the County of Washington my true and lawful Attorney for me in my name and to my use to sell deliver recover & receive of Matthew Harrison & David Harrison all that is due to me payable to their contract with me in a bond given for the sum of Twenty Pounds in specie or Monies at what they would have sold for in the Year 1779 for causing myself a substitute in the said Matthew Harrison's name to receive a Soldier in the Continental Army until the last day of December 1781 & giving and by these presents granting to my said Attorney my sole and full power & authority to take pursue and follow such legal course for the recovery recovering & obtaining the same as I myself might or could do were I personally present and for receipt of the same as payment or other sufficient discharge for me and in my name to make & give receipt of Deliver and also use all legal methods for settling and adjusting all my accounts that will be settled on or before the 1st day of March And do further give my Attorney full and ample power to sell & convey all or any part of any property that may come into his hands from or in my Name & to my use ratifying & confirming all and every of his contracts & Bargains as if I myself being personally present.
