of the aforesaid money or estate to transmit the same to either  
William or John H. Brown Merchants of Philadelphia to be  
handed over to us, hereby Ratifying Confirming and allowing all  
and whatsoever our said Attorney shall lawfully do in the execution  
of this power, and if necessary we do hereby empower our said Attorney  
to make Constitute & appoint one or more Attorneys under him & them  
at his pleasure to revoke, In Witness whereof we do hereby set  
our hands & affix our seals this seventh day of March in the year  
of our Lord God one Thousand Eight hundred and six,
