

may be entitled as his next of kin and on recovery thereof or if any part thereof receipts releases or other sufficient discharges for the same for us and in our names or in his own name to make seal and deliver and also to compound and agree for the same, and generally we do hereby jointly & severally empower our said Attorney to do and Transact all such other lawful acts & things in the premises either in his own or our names as fully & Effectually to all intents and purposes as we ourselves might or could do were we personally present at the doing thereof, and on receipt or recovery of all or any part of the afore said money or Estate to Transmit the same to Messrs William or John H. Brown Merchants of Philadelphia to be handed over to us, hereby Ratifying Confirming and allowing all and whatsoever our said Attorney shall lawfully do in the execution of this power, and if necessary we do hereby, empower our said Attorney to make constitute & appoint one or more Attorneys under him & them at his pleasure to Revoke, In Witness whereof we do hereby set our hands & affix our seals this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord God one Thousand Eight hundred and six,
