Will

I James Campbell of Washington County in the State of Virginia being sick and weak in body, but of sound mind memory and understanding, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit: First of all I give and bequeath unto my mother Mary and Sister Martha Campbell my Negro woman Ebe and her son Billy, to have the use and benefit of them during the life of my said mother and Sister Martha and after their decease, I give and bequeath to my brother Patrick and his heirs the above named Ebe and her Offspring and her son Billy forever. Also I give and bequeath to my brother Patrick and his heirs forever my Negro boy Joe and one Bay Mare. Also to my Sister Sarah I give and bequeath my Negro girl Nancy to her and her heirs forever, also one Bay Colt.

Also I give and bequeath to my Sister Martha forty Dollars to be paid by my brother Patrick within one year after my decease and also one feather Bed. To my Sister Martha <sup>to my</sup> Sister Sarah I give and bequeath my cattle to be equally divided between them. Also I give and bequeath to my Sister Anne Rowan one negro Girl named Diley who is now in her possession, to her and her heirs forever. And I hereby nominate and appoint my brother John Campbell executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of February one thousand seven hundred and twenty three.
