

This Indenture made the first day of Juny in the
 year of our Lord eighteen hundred and six Between James Dailey of the
 County of Washington State of Virginia of the one part and Arthur Bowen
 of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that
 that the said James Dailey in order to secure the payment of the fol-
 lowing Debt to wit one Debt due John and William Byars of one hun-
 dred and fifty Dollars and a nother due John Byars of two
 hundred and fifty Dollars with Interest on them agreeable to said
 Bonds - and in consideration of of one Dollar to him in hand paid
 by this said Arthur Bowen at or before the executing & delivery of these
 presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged He this said
 James Dailey hath granted Bargained and sold and by these pre-
 sents doth grant Bargain and sell unto this said Arthur Bowen all my
 Stock of Horses & Cattle & Household furniture consisting of four
 head of Horse beast to wit one Black 1 Sorrel mare one Black
 Horse & Cattle two head of Cattle three Beds & furniture
 together with every other article of household furniture what-
 ever I am now possessed of & all my plantation utensils of every
 kind and all the Gear which I now have to - - -
 Together with all the Inversion and profit of the same from the
 date hereof for and during the term of one year and two months
 and the reversion and remainder and remainders right title Interest
 trust property claim and demand whatsoever both at law and equity
 of him the said James Dailey in to a set of the same arising. To have
 and to hold the property herein before mentioned with every
 right therein to this said Arthur Bowen his Heirs &c upon
 Trust. Now Whereas should this said James Dailey pay or
 cause to be paid the Debt before mentioned to this John &
 William Byars & this said John Byars together with the lawful
 Interest thereon and the Cost of this Deed of Trust on or before
 the twenty fifth day of Decr 1806 then this Deed of Trust
 to be of no force otherwise on his failing to do the same by
 that time then the said Arthur Bowen shall as soon as conveni-

ent thereafter, shall proceed to advertise this said property in some publick
news paper printed nearest to the said Dailey two more times previous
to the day of Sale, and proceeds accordingly to sell the said property
for the best price he can for ready money to the highest bid-
der, and out of the Monies arising from such Sale first
pay the expences attending the same and then the Debts before
mentioned and the Bal^e if any, to return to the said James Dailey
or his lawful representative as soon thereafter as may be, This in-
strument of writing or Deed of Trust to have the full force of a
Deed of Trust in every instance in as ample a manner as if all
the forms which any law could point out was inserted herein the
meaning and intention of it is to secure the Debts above men-
tioned to my Creditors aforesaid In Witness whereof I have
Sett my hand & Seal and deliver this writing as my act &
Deed the Day and year above mentioned.
