In the Name of God Amen I James Glenn of
 of Washington County Commonwealth of Virginia being at present
 though weak of body yet of perfect mind and memory and
 calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and that it is
 appointed for all men once to die and after death to
 come to Judgment Do make and Ordain this my last
 Will and Testament in the manner and form following viz
 first and principally I recommend my soul to Almighty God
 who gave it and my body to the earth from whence it
 was taken to be buried in a christian like manner at
 the discretion of my executors hereafter mentioned and as for
 such worldly things as it hath pleased God to bestow
 with in this life I give and bequeath as follows viz
 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary all her
 wearing Apparel her books and Bible and one third of
 all my personal Estate and that she shall hold my
 plantation whomever I now dwell and that she shall have
 the benefit of all my grain that may be in my possession
 at my decease as well to that is growing as what is sowed
 together with my flock of hogs one pair and some two pair
 of Geese until my youngest child shall attain to the age of

fourteen years for the raising of my children and schooling of them but in case of her contracting a second marriage before my youngest child shall arrive at ^{age of} fourteen years she shall have no longer the benefit aforesaid of my plantation only her ~~husband~~ shall remain to her as above.

I Will also that my sons David William Benjamin and John shall be bound by my executors to such trades as they shall choose at such ages as my executors shall adjudge most to their advantages. I will also that the Compend what now or may be due to me my just debts and funeral charges be fully paid and satisfied may be equally divided amongst all my children namely Robert James Mary Elizabeth David Sean William Benjamin and John when they shall arrive at the age of twenty one years but in case any of my daughters shall contract matrimony before they shall arrive at ¹⁸ age they shall then have their parts paid them and further my Will is that if my son James shall satisfy and pay his brothers and sisters their parts as they shall arrive to age after my youngest child shall be fourteen years of age of my real Estate according as it shall be appraised that then he my said son James shall hold the same forever to him his heirs or assigns otherwise it shall be sold by my executors to the real advantage and equally divided among all ^{my} said children. Well Reserving a reasonable maintenance to my wife out of my said real estate during her widowhood and further if any of my children dies before they shall arrive at full age becoming to law leaving no lawful issue their share shall be equally divided among my surviving children. And Lastly I do make constitute and Ordain and appoint my beloved wife and James Duffey executors to this my last Will and Testament revoking and making void all former Wills and Testaments by me made ~~notwithstanding~~ ~~and~~ confirming this and this only as my last Will and Testament and these my executors. As Witness my hand and face this 24th day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety one
