 if any, I do will and appoint to Samuel Buchanan In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
 this twenty seventh day of March one thousand seven
 hundred & Eighty

Know all Men by these presents that I Alexander Moore of Washington County and State of Virginia have bargained and sold and made over
 unto Andrew Milammon, of the said County and State, all the Cattle that grazes on the plantation I now live on. To wit two white Cows
 one black and white Cow, with a short tail and one red and white ditto. Also one white Horse, about eight years old, fat and in condition
 for sale. And I have paid to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge. And I hereby warrant and defend said Horse
 and the said Milammon, from all Men, or manner of Persons, having any just claim thereto. Witness my hand and seal
 this twenty second day of May, One thousand seven hundred and eighty four.
