Martin of the County of Henry and State of Virginia
have nominated, constituted and appointed and by
these presents do by these presents nominate and
appoint General James Robertson of Davidson County in the
Territory South of the river Ohio my lawful attorney for
me and in my name to convey a certain tract of land
lying in Davidson County the territory aforesaid, containing
six hundred and forty acres known by the name of
Samuel Martin's preemption near Nashville to William
Edmiston Esquire State aforesaid Washington in full
simple in my name to convey and execute as
fully to all intents and purposes as fully as I could
do was I personally present.
