I John Gibson of Rockbridge County and State of Virginia, School keeper, Being frail in body, but of perfect mind and memory; thanks to god for all his mercies; Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and testament: that is to say, principal and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned or friends; nothing doubting but, at the general Resurrection, I shall receive the same again, by the mighty power of god. next that all my Just debts be paid; next I Bequeath to my beloved Nephew John Gibson, Son of Andrew Gibson of Winchester Frederick County Virginia, said John Gibson, now lives near Shenando, Washington County Virginia, all my Estate Real & personal; viz; such as Clothing or wearables, Books, debts, bills, bonds, notes, Cash, or ready money; all goods & Chattles or whatever property I may be possessed of immediately at my Decease: to the use and behoof of the said John Gibson, his heirs or assigns, forever and I do constitute and ordain the said John Gibson, and John Patton of Lexington, Rockbridge County Virginia; my Executors to the

my last will and testament; and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former testaments, wills, legacies, Bequests, and executors, by gone, in any ways before named, willed and bequeathed; Ratifying and confirming this, and no other, to be my last will and testament. in witness whereof I have set my hand and seal: this eleventh day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three,
