

In the name of god Amen I John Haden being of perfect mind & memory but weak in body and knowing the mortality of the body that it is appointed for all men once ^{to} do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, Viz. 1st I commend my soul to god who give its Existence And 2^d My body to the Earth in hopes of a glorious resurrection, Expecting a decent burial at the discretion of my Executors And 3^d I Give and bequeath to my son Wm. Haden the following part of the land I now possess &c to begin at a white Oak corner to James Wheelers survey to run S 68° E 205 poles crossing the survey to the last line of the Original survey made in the name of Tho: Tate thence N 92° E 178 poles &c to run the remaining line in such manner & form as to include one hundred & four acres in the said survey, which I Give & bequeath to my son William during the minority of my son James Haden at which time his claim to that land is extinct & all the lands I possess to be Equally divided Among my sons Viz To my son William one sixth part 2^d To my son John one sixth part & to my son Tho: one sixth part & to my son Robert one sixth & to my son George one sixth part & to my son James one sixth part only with this difference that my son William shall ^{have} choice so as to have privilege to take his part within the abovementioned one hundred & four acres as to secure his improvement 4th I Give and bequeath to my four daughters all & every item of my moveable property after my legal debts ^{are} paid Viz To Jane one fourth part 2^d To my daughter Mary one fourth part & 3^d To my daughter Hannah one fourth part & to my daughter Nancy one fourth part of all my moveable property 5th & to my dearly beloved wife Margaret one third part of all during her natural lifetime. I do hereby make void & of no effect all other bequeaths & do hereby ratify & confirm this to be my last Will & Testament appointing John ^{William} Haden & my wife Margaret Haden to be my sole Executors & Executrix in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & nine

 Perfect mind & memory & balking to mind the uncertainty of this life
 & that it is appointed for all men Once to die & after death to come
 to judgment Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in the
 manner following first & principally I recommend my soul to God
 who gave it & my body to the Earth from whence it was taken to
 be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of
 my Ecc^l. hereafter mentioned & as for such worldly things as it hath
 Pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & bequeath as
 follows Viz

I presume I will that all my just Debts are fully paid & satisfied
 them I give to my beloved Wife Mary one brown mare saddle & bridle
 all the Beds & Beddings that I shall be possessed of Together with all
 my house hold & kitchen furniture Except as hereafter Excepted One Cow
 & Calf of her own Choice One Ewe & Two lambs Together with Ten
 bushels of Wheat Ten Do of Rye & Ten of Corn yearly & every year during
 her natural life out of my Plantation the Wheat & Rye to be paid the
 first Day of Oct^r the Corn the 25th Dec^r. to be delivered on the
 Premises.

I give to my son in law Archibald McGinnis five shill^{ds} his wife
 Mary having Rec^d. what I allotted her

I give to my son Saml. five shill^{ds} he have Rec^d. as above

I give To my son in law Seth Porterfield five shill^{ds}.

I give To my son John five shill^{ds}.

I give & bequeath To my son Hugh all the real estate that I be
 possessed of at my decease With him paying the incumbrances of my
 Wife I will that Each of my Grandsons, if my Real Estate will admit
 that is named afore may be found to my Ecc^l. in a new pocket Book that
 my son Saml. shall have my best suit of Cloths my son John my second
 suit & my son Hugh all my remaining apparel save my great Coat that
 I give to my step son Edwards Smith I will that I will also that the Price
 of a horse that I sold to Mr. Fuller may be divided Equally between my
 Two Grand sons Saml. & Will^m. Scott Children of my son W^m. Dec^d. & the
 Remainder if any there be Divided among all my Grand Children
