One Colt all my household and kitchen
furniture such as bed and furniture chests
tables bureau, cupboards and furniture pots
ovens &c all my hogs saddles and bridles
V increase of all debt payd it being my property
and in my possession at the time of executing
this Instrument and I the said John Hagarty Sen.
for myself my heirs &c do Covenant with the
said Robert M. Hagarty and his heirs that I for
myself and my heirs will for ever warrant and
defend the said Property above mentioned to
the said Robert M. Hagarty and his heirs
against the claims of all persons whatever
further the said Robert M. Hagarty doth agree
to let the said John Hagarty Sen. have the
use of the above property all he calls for it
yet upon Condition nevertheless that if the
said John Hagarty or his heirs &c shall
well and truly pay the said Robert M. Hagarty
or his heirs &c the sum of One hundred
& Seventy one dollars and twenty five cents then
this bill of sale and every thing herein
contained shall be void and of none effect
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

Wilson Quarles of the County of Caroline and
State aforesaid at or before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
said John Thompson Senr do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained sold and delivered
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
unto the said Wilson Quarles his executors administra-
tors and assigns all my goods and chattels of
every description which I now possess and the
increase and profit of the same hereinafter
particularly mentioned that is to say one negro
man named David One named Ben one
named Christolm one lad named Garland
One girl named Nancy and one named
Rhodah and one negro woman named Easter
three head of horses to wit one bay horse one
bay and one sorrel mare one pair of yoke
of oxen five head of cattle one head of
hogs and all my household and kitchen
furniture and plantation utensils of every
