

This Indenture

made and concluded the 11th Day of September

1722. Witnesseth that the Court of Washington County Virginia have viewed and heard William Christian
 Debra Peter of. Nancy (deceased) Apprenice to Samuel Chelie of said County Wheelwright, to be taught in the
 said service Trade or Occupation of a Wheelwright which to the said Samuel Chelie now north and with him
 as an Apprenice to dwell continue and serve from the Day of the Date hereof until he shall be Twenty one
 Years of Age he being now about five Years old) During all which Term the said Apprenice his said Master
 shall be bound to do all such things as his said Master shall command him to do and he shall not do nor willfully suffer it to be done by others, but of the same to his power shall forthwith give notice to his
 said Master, The goods of his said Master he shall not embezzle or waste nor lend them without his consent
 to any. At Cards, Dice or any other unlawful game he shall not play, In revenge or Malice he shall not
 frequent Quarrels he shall not commit, Nothing he shall not contract, from the service of his said
 Master he shall not at any time depart or absent himself without his said Masters leave but in all things
 shall demean himself as a faithful Apprenice ought to do, Towards his said Master and all his during the
 said Term, And the said Master his said Apprenice the said Trade of a Wheelwright with all things thereunto
 belonging, shall & will teach or cause to be taught and instructed after the best way and manner that he can
 and shall also teach or cause him to be taught to read and write and shall and will also find & allow
 unto his said Apprenice, Meat, Drink, washing lodging and Apparel and all other things necessary
 for such an Apprenice during the Term aforesaid and at the end of the said Term shall and will give
 to his said Apprenice one new suit of apparel. In Witness whereof we have hereunto indistinguishably
 set our Hands & Seals to this Indenture the Day and Year above written.

 performance of the above assignment and warrant I bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
 in two Hundred Pounds pecuniary to the said John Kennedy his heirs Executors Administrators
 given under my Hand and Seal this 5th Day of February 1722
