WHEREAS William King, John Mitchell and George Thompson executed a power of Attorney to Robert P. Currier bearing date Abingdon twenty fourth day of November one thousand eight hundred and three. Authorizing & empowering said Robert P. Currier to settle the business of Robert Mitchell and William King trading merchants under the firm of Robert Mitchell & Co as per Articles of Copartnership between said King and Mitchell bearing date the third day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, which said Copartnership contract makes known that one half is coming to the heirs of said Mitchell and one half to said William King his heirs &c. This is therefore to certify that said Currier settled said business to our satisfaction as per final settlement the twenty fifth day of April one thousand eight hundred and seven it appearing that the said Robert P. Currier fell indebted on the above settlement to the estate of Robert Mitchell three thousand nine hundred forty one dollars and thirteen cents and to William King three thousand nine hundred forty one dollars and thirteen $\frac{1}{2}$ cents for which said sums Robert P. Currier & Co executed their bond to

John Mitchell acting heir of the said Robert Mitchell
for three thousand nine hundred forty one dollars and
thirteen and 3/4 cents and authorized a debit to their amount on
the books of William King for three thousand nine hundred
forty one dollars and thirteen 3/4 cents which when the said
sums are paid will be in full for all and every demand or
demands that we or either of us have or had against him
the said Robert P. Cumie for his appointment as Attorney
aforesaid and for all his acts relative to said business; the
house and Lot in the Town of Franklin standing as the
property of the heirs of William King and John Mitchell.
