I know all Men by these presents that Alexander Moon for and in consideration of nine Pound
Twelve Shillings Virginia money for me in hand paid by Andrew Sullivan, Have bargained & sold
to the said Andrew the whole crop of Small grain now growing on the plantation wherein I
now live, supposed to be about nine acres of Rye and three Acres of Wheat to the same
more or less. And I do warrant the said Grant to the said Andrew against all
Persons - Witness my Hand and Seal the Twenty second day of May One
Thousand seven hundred and eighty four

At a Court held for Washington County 24th June 1784
This Bill of Sale from Alexander Moon to Andrew Sullivan
was proven by the Oaths of Ebenezer Qualep and John
Bernady Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
