Virginia for and in consideration of the sum
of four thousand five hundred dollars lawful money
of the United States to me in hand paid by
Wilson Quarles of the County of Caroline and
State aforesaid at or before the sealing and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
said John Thompson Senr do hereby acknowledge
have granted bargained sold and delivered
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell
unto the said Wilson Quarles his executors administra-
tors and assigns all my goods and chattels of
every description which I now possess and the
increase and profit of the same hereinafter
particularly mentioned that is to say one negro
man named David One named Ben one
named Christolm one lad named Garland
One girl named Nancy and one named
Rhodah and one negro woman named Easter
three head of horses to wit one bay horse one
bay and one sorrel mare one pair of yoke
of oxen five head of cattle one head of
hogs and all my household and kitchen
furniture and plantation utensils of every

and two guns and the increase of the above
 mentioned property together all and singular
 which said promises are now remaining standing
 and being now in my possession To have and
 to hold all and singular the said personal
 estate aforesaid including the household
 furniture and then the promises above
~~bargained and sold or mentioned or intended~~
 to be mentioned to the said Wilson Quarles
 his executors administrators and assigns forever and
 I the said John Thompson Sent. for myself
 my heirs executors and administrators all and
 singular the said goods &c. unto the said
 Wilson Quarles his executors administrators
 and assigns against me the said John
 Thompson Sent. my executors and administrators
 and against all and every other person and
 persons whatsoever shall and will warrant
 and forever defend. by these presents of all
 and singular which said goods and
 chattels above named to wit seven negroes
 David, Jim, Easton, Chisholm, Garland,
 Nancy and Rhoads. three head of horses one
 cart Voason five head of cattle six head
 of hogs and all my household and kitchen
 furniture of every description and two guns
 I the said John Thompson Sent. have put
 the said Wilson Quarles in full possession
 by delivering to him the said Wilson Quarles
 one bed and furniture at the sealing &
 delivery of these presents in the name of
 the whole premises hereby bargained and sold
 or mentioned or intended to be mentioned
 unto him the said Wilson Quarles as aforesaid
 In witness whereof I the said John
 Thompson have put my hand and affixed

my seal this the 12th day of March One thousand
eight hundred and eight
