In the Name of God Amen. I John Robinson
Washington County & Commonwealth of Virginia being at present of sound
mind and memory and considering that it is appointed for all
men to die, and being at this time in a very low state of
health and not knowing when it may please the Divine
providence to call me from time to eternity I do hereby make
this my last Will and Testament, that is to say (first and
principally) I recommend my soul to God who gave it and
my body to the Earth there to be decently buried
After I do direct all my lawfull Debts to be paid and
my funeral charges and then my beloved wife Elizabeth
Robison to have all my personal Estate to whom I do
bequeath during her natural life and if there should
be any part thereof then left I do desire it to be equally
divided amongst my four children if they are then alive
or such of them as may be then alive, and I do hereby
appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth my sole executor
of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
Wills by me before made. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal
this twentieth day of November 1795
