and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto Jacob Moore
of the county and State aforesaid my team of horses as they now
stand viz one Grey mare one brown horse and one bay horse
together with my waggon and all the gear therewith belonging
for values received and for myself and my heirs and assigns
do warrant and defend the said waggon & team from all persons
whatsoever claiming the same James Garner under my hand and
Seal this 20th day of October 1797.

The Condition of the above bill of Sale is such that
if I the said Jonas Garner do pay or cause to be paid
unto the said Jacob Moore the sum of one hundred
dollars fully doleant to be paid at or upon the first day
of December in the year one thousand seven hundred and
ninety seven and fifty dollars to be paid at or upon the
first day of January in the year one thousand seven
hundred

hundred and ninety eight then these presents to be
void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
in Law Given under my hand this 20th day
of October 1797
