Virginia being sick in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God for all his Mercies to me. I now calling
to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make this my last Will & Testament
that is to say, finally & for all I give and recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it and
my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but of the
general Resurrection I shall receive it again by the mighty power of God.

And as touching such worldly goods as I have
I will please God to bestow on both in this life & give and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Andrew Elder Ten pounds current money of Virginia, to be paid in one Year after my
decease if the price of my plantation which I sold in Archbidge can be recovered in that time, and if not, as soon as it can be recovered.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Agnes Johnson Ten Pounds to be paid in the same manner aforesaid.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughters Martha Elder Ten Pounds if she or her Husband comes and demands it in her lifetime.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Elder Ten Pounds to be paid as directed as directed in my last Will.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Johnson her bed and furniture, and Ten Pounds to be paid in the manner

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Robert and James Elder my Plantation whereon I now live, to be divided equally

between them according to quantity and quality which I give to them their heirs & assigns for ever. And if the Plantation should

remain in their hands till either should die having no children, the other to possess the whole.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Johnson Ten Pounds to be paid as before mentioned.

Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Rebecca one Negro boy named Jack, and if should die before marriage, the said Negro to be equally divided

between my Son James and my Daughter Leah.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Robert one Negro child named Pompey to him and his heirs for ever, likewise two Horses known to be claimed by him.

Item, After my former wife gets her third which she is to get, the rest is to be equally divided between my Son & Daughters herein

named, that is to say Robert, James, Rebecca, and Leah.

Item the two given, Negroes is to work on the place till my youngest child is 18 years, except my Executors think proper to sell them in order to get others in their room.

And I do constitute and appoint my loving wife and Son Robert my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament

to sell and pay of the other legacies as before mentioned, discharging and making good all other former Wills, Legacies and

Bequests whatsoever, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.
