Each and Mary and Eve and Margaret and Barberen and Rachel Kullup
my Step Daughter these last mentioned Daughters and Step Daugh-
ter to have thirty Pounds Each then Elisabeth to have an Equal Part
in my Estate and these grand Children Manuel and Sarah Walters
after Received the above mention fifteen Pound and Mary Eve and Ma-
