County of Washington in the state of Virginia for divers good causes and
unto moving have constituted and appointed John Keys of said County
my special Lawful Attorney for me and in my Name and to my use to
sell convey or rent a certain Tract or parcels of Land lying on the South
a branch of the south fork of Holstein river in said County. Containing
rightly four acres of Land or some more or less and also that my said
Attorney pay out of the first part of the price of the Land that hereby
receives for the rent or purchase money all legal fees for the obtaining a
Patent for said Land and the price of a Horse I purchased from him for
the sum of twelve Pound currency aforesaid price and I do by these presents
fully ratify and confirm all the lawful acts and doings of my said Attorney
as if I myself were personally present. As witness my hand and seal
this 24th day of September 1785.

To all to whom these presents may concern Know ye that I Thomas Sharp
of the County of Davidson in the State of North Carolina for several good causes
me thereunto moving have ^{named} and constituted me by these presents as my ^{own} ^{attorney} ^{and} ^{attorneys}
and appoint my brother John Sharp and my brother law George
Marshall both of the County of Davidson and said State my true and lawful
attorneys that they or either of them for me and in my name and to my
use to ask demand sue for recover and receive of Col. Robert Crain of
the County of Washington in the State of Virginia two Bonds dated October
14th 1786 and conditioned each for the payment of a ^{liberty} ^{going} ^{freedom}
allow according to the tenor of the Bonds giving and hereby granting
to my attorneys or either of them my full power and authority to
use and perform all such lawful acts and devices as shall be necessary
for the recovering of the said Bonds and to make and give acquittances or other
discharges in my name and generally to do and execute in the premises
as fully as I myself could do being personally present and also to
impower my said attorneys or either of them to make unto the said Robert
Crain a title in fee simple to a certain tract of Land lying in
