I Moses Edmondson of Washington County and state of Virginia in my sound mind and memory bearing in mind the mortality of my Body and that it is appointed for all men once to die do make this my last Will and testament and do hereby disannull and Void all my former Wills and testaments and first of all I Recommend my Soul to god who gave it and my body to the dust to be buried in a decent Manner at the orders of my executors and as to the worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me I do dispose of it in the following manner to wit I allow all my lawfull and Just debts of my own Contracting and that my son John has contracted before the date hereof to be paid I leave to my son David all that land now in his possession I leave to my son John one dun colored Mare I leave to my son Moses one sorrel mare I leave to my Daughter Hannah forty shillings worth of property I leave to my Daughter Geon forty shillings worth of property I leave to my daughter Elizabeth forty shillings worth of property I leave to my Daughter Nancy ten Dollars worth of property I leave to my Daughter Rachel forty shillings worth of property I leave to my son William forty shillings worth of property I leave to my Beloved wife Rachel the plantation Innow live on with all the profits arising there from During her Natural life time and at her Decease I allow it to my son Moses. I leave to my wife Rachel one Negro woman named Polly and one Negro girl named Rose. I leave to my son John one Negro boy named Ned and all the Rest of my property not before mentioned I leave to my wife Rachel I appoint David Edmondson and John Edmondson to be my Sole Executors of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth day of Aprile in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and six
