Know all men by these presents that I Nicholas Reagan of the county of Washington in the State of Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid by William King of the county aforesaid doth Manumit and emancipate my negro man slave James pursuant to the Act of the Assembly of the Commonwealth of Virginia in such cases made and provided.

This Instrument is intended by me to Liberate from Slavery, and to make free the said James from the 20th day of August 1799 (nine) and from thence forwards forever Witness my hand and Seal this 20th day of August 1799.

This Instrument from Nicholas Reagan emancipating his negro man James was acknowledged in court by the said Nicholas Reagan and ordered to be recorded.
