all Men by these Presents that I Jas: Robinson of Washington County and State of Virginia have bargained and sold unto Adam Calk of Lancaster County & State of Pennsylvania one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in Washington County on the north side of Holston River beginning on said River so as to include Sandhills spring thence down the River across the King Creek to the second small branch below it Creek which Land I warrant and defend from all persons claiming the same by force right, except the United States, or the Lord of the Soil - I also bind myself to deliver said Land and first title agreeing to the said Calk by the last Day of October next for the consideration of One thousand and seventy pounds current Money of Virginia to me in hand paid by the said Calk.
