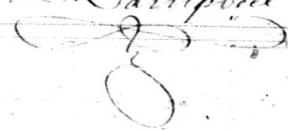

In the Name of God Amen I James Smock of the County of Washington and State of Virginia Being Very sick in body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto God Calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend the earth to be buried in decent order at the discretion of my executors and my worldly estate I give, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form, First I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Leah all that I now possess during her lifetime and after her decease to my two sons John and Jacob, shall have all the horses and farming Utensils and one cow each the horses and farming Utensils to be equally divided between them and the rest of the house hold Goods, And Cattle to my two daughters Rachel & Sarah to be equally divided between them and I do hereby utterly Disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments wills legacies bequests and executors by me in any wise before named I likewise constitute make and ordain the sole Executors my mother Sarah Smock & my wife Leah I confirm this to be my last Will and Testament In witness where I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of July one thousand eight hundred & twelve Signed sealed published pronounced
