Know all men by these presents that we James Mitchell & George
Mitchell of Kindroghead in the Parish of Culluff in the County of Donegal
in that part of the United Kingdom Called Ireland farmers, and Sarah Mitch-
ell of same place Spinster, which said James George and Sarah are the
Brothers & Sister of Robert Mitchell late of the Town of Franklin in
Williamson County, State of Tennessee In the United States of America
Merchant deceased have nominated authorized constituted and appointed
and by these presents, do nominate authorize constitute and appoint
and in our places and stead jointly & severally put our brother John
Mitchell of Hallville near Abingdon in the County of Washington
State of Virginia in the said United States of America Merchant, as our
True and lawful attorney for us and in our and each of our names to
for demands recover and receive of and ^{from} William King of Washington County
& State of Virginia aforesaid the copartner of our said late brother all
sums & sums of money Goods Estate or Effects, which may be due & owing
unto us or which may belong to us in right of our said brother as
copartner of said William King, and to take all lawful ways and means
whatsoever either at Law or in equity as he may Judge necessary to
recover the same and bring said William King to a speedy settle-
ment, and upon receipt or recovery of all or any part of said money Estate
goods and chattles, releases receipts or other sufficient discharges
for the same to the said William King to ^{make} seal and deliver either
in their own or our names as may be deemed necessary and also
we do hereby Impower our said Attorney to settle in whatever
manner he may deem best for a house and lot in the town of Frank-
lin aforesaid hereby for us and each of us relinquishing all claim to
the same if he shall think it necessary so to do and hereby declaring
ourselves perfectly satisfied with whatever our said Attorney shall
do in the premises, & binding us and each of us & our and each of our
heirs Executors and adm^{rs} to stand to & abide by the same and if
needs be We do hereby authorize our said Attorney, to administer to the
Estate of our said deceased brother Robert Mitchell in his own or our
names, and to take such steps either by arrest attachment distress or
otherwise as he may think proper, against all & every person & persons
whatsoever for all money goods Estate or Effects, which belonged to
our said deceased brother at his decease, or to which we or either of us

may be entitled as his next of kin and on recovery thereof or if any part thereof receipts releases or other sufficient discharges for the same for us and in our names or in his own name to make seal and deliver and also to compound and agree for the same, and generally we do hereby jointly & severally empower our said Attorney to do and transact all such other lawful acts & things in the premises either in his own or our names as fully & Effectually to all intents and purposes as we ourselves might or could do were we personally present at the doing thereof, and on receipt or recovery of all or any part of the aforesaid money or estate to transmit the same to Messrs William or John H. Brown Merchants of Philadelphia to be handed over to us, hereby Ratifying Confirming and allowing all and whatsoever our said attorney shall lawfully do in the execution of this power, and if necessary we do hereby, empower our said Attorney to make constitute & appoint one or more attorneys under him & them at his pleasure to Revoke, In Witness whereof we do hereby set our hands & affix our seals this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord God one Thousand Eight hundred and six,
