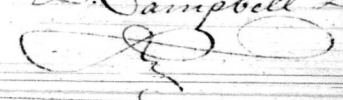

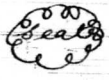

Be it Remembered that I Robert Warsham of the County of Washington & State of Virginia, Being in a low state of Health but of sound mind & memory, do constitute this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say, after all my Just debts & funeral expences be paid, I desire the residue may be divided as follows — first I leave the whole of my estate in the hands of my beloved Wife Jane Warsham, for the maintenance of herself & child or children, as the case may be, I put it out on interest or such part as she may think proper.
