The last will and testament of Saml. Edmiston Senr.

I Samuel Edmiston of Washington County and State of Virginia being in my perfect senses do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit. 1st I authorize and direct my executor to collect all just debts due to me and out of the money collected by them to pay all just demands against my estate. 2nd I bequeath unto my son David Edmiston three hundred acres of my land on the waters of Elk river, my negro woman Peg, Negro Boy Niah, a good horse and saddle one of my beds and furniture thereof, a decent support from the farm whereon I now live, which support is to continue during his natural life or so long as he may choose to live on the said plantation, which property together with two milch cows I devise unto the said David in fee simple. 3rd I bequeath unto my daughter Mary during her natural life and not in fee simple three hundred acres of land on the waters of Elk river, my negro girl Peg and Negro boy Charles, a good mare, a steerskin three cash, which negroes, mare, steerskin and beds are now in her possession. But if this devise should have effect the above bequeathed property shall at the death of

my daughter pass to them otherwise it shall revert to my heirs
 jointly. 11th I bequeath unto my son Samuel the tract of land
 whereon I now live in fee simple provided he will furnish
 my son David with a decent maintenance during his natural
 life or so long as David may choose to live with him if
 Samuel refuses to comply with the conditions aforesaid
 then one hundred acres of the land is to be disposed
 of by my executors for the benefit of David unless
 Samuel will give bond with good security for the performance
 of the condition of this request. it is my will that the said Samuel be bound to
 support the said David so long as he the said David
 continues single and no longer. I further bequeath in
 fee simple unto my son Samuel my negro men Tom
 and Dany my negro woman Phillis and her children
 Bob and Syney my negro woman Esthen and her
 children Ned, Rosa, and John three beds and the
 furniture appertaining to them the house and kitchen
 furniture the residue of my personal property and
 money except what may be necessary for procuring
 titles to my Elk river lands. I leave my old negro
 man Harry to the care of my son Samuel recommending
 to him to take proper care of him during life. 5th I
 bequeath in fee simple unto my son John one thousand
 acres of my land on the waters of Elk river. 6th I
 bequeath in fee simple unto my Grandson Samuel Comiston
 three hundred acres of land on the waters of Elk
 river. 7th I bequeath in fee simple unto my Grandson
 Samuel Comiston Watson three hundred acres of
 land on the waters of Elk river, and one hundred
 and fifty dollars in money to be paid to him by
 my son Samuel. 8th I bequeath in fee simple
 unto my Grandson Samuel Comiston Gilmore three
 hundred acres of my land on the waters of Elk
 river. I authorize and direct my executors or either
 of them to make a title to John McEwell and
 Benjamin Estill jointly to fifteen hundred acres
 of my land on the waters of Elk river agreeable
 to a bond executed by me to said Estill. Also

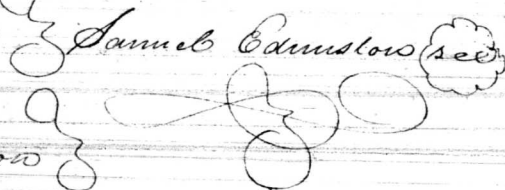
Convey to David Martin or his representatives a tract of Land lying in Washington County on the South side of middle fork of Holston river containing seven acres and patented in my name as my lands on Elk river are in dispute and some of them may be lost it is my will that the loss if any be proportioned among the devisees and that each devisee lose in proportion to the quantity bequeathed to him. And in either case that if the division of the land be made as soon as the titles to said land are perfected as equitably and fairly as possible. Lastly I do constitute and appoint my two sons John and Samuel and May^r Thomas Edmiston, executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking annulling and disallowing all other or former wills by me made, ratifying and confirming this my last will and testament and no others.
