Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Munn
of the County of Sevier in the State of Tennessee for and in
consideration of the sum of ^{one} dollar current money of the
United States to me in hand paid, have bargained and sold
and do hereby assign and transfer to John Campbell of the
County of Washington in the State of Virginia all the
right which I have acquired to a certain tract or parcel
of Land in Lee County formerly Washington by an
entry with the Surveyor of the said County of Washington
and the warrant upon which said entry was made,

which entry follows in these words: "November 12th 1793
 Samuel Beussell with others his former entries one on
 Trading Creek one at the Hurricane one at the Turkey
 Cove and the surplus of his entry one land creek
 and water by State warrant No. 1988 - 300 acres
 of Land in Washington County lying on both
 sides of powder river beginning at the first branch
 that empties into said river on the South side
 below Elms Place and running down for
 quantity" And for the purpose of investing
 in the said John Campbell and his heirs or assigns
 an infeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple
 in the said entry of Land it is hereby constituted
 and appoint the said John Campbell my lawful
 and irrevocable attorney with full power and
 Authority in my name and for his own benefit
 and advantage to act in all things
 touching and concerning the said premises as fully and
 amply as I could do were I personally present
 or as if I had not sold and transferred
 the said entry and warrant that I do hereby further
 Authorize and empower the said John Campbell
 to demand and receive from the Surveyor of the
 County of Lee a plat and certificate of survey of
 the said entry of three hundred acres if the State
 think proper to have the same surveyed, and on
 receiving the said plat and Survey in my name
 and for his use an agreement to make thereof to
 himself and if he shall not think proper to have
 the said entry surveyed to assign and transfer
 the warrant on which it is made to himself or
 any other person for his benefit and advantages

I do hereby authorize and empower the said John
Campbell in my name and for his use and benefit
to assign and transfer to himself or any other persons
for his benefit and advantage all Land office Treas-
ury warrants or parts of warrants remaining in the
Surveyors office of Washington County aforesaid not
yet Located or transferred by me to any other person
hereby ratifying and confirming all and every thing
which shall be done acted and performed by my said
attorney John Campbell by virtue of these presents
