The Last Will and Testament of William Ryburn

James Orr and Leonard Hutton two of the subscribing
witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on
the motion of Patrick Ryburn the executor therein
named who took the oath prescribed by law and together
with Leonard Hutton and John Ryburn his security
entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of
three thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs.
A Certificate for the probat of the said will is
therefore granted to the said Patrick Ryburn in
due form.

owing unto me the said Simon Ely by and from the
said debtors and to have use and take all lawful
ways and means in my name or otherwise for the
recovery thereof by attachment arrest Distress or otherwise
and to compound and agree for the same and
acquittance or other sufficient discharges for the same
for me and in my name to make seal and deliver
sell and make titles to a tract of land lying and

303 being on one of the north branches of Beaver creek the said track lies joining ^{the} farm of M^r. Peter Munrover and William Bolton Washington County State of Virginia. Also sell and make titles to a certain track of land lying in Pools valley Lee County State of Virginia turkey cove it being a tract of land the said Simon Ely bought of Walter Preston the said Tract of land that the said Simon Ely formerly lived on and to all other acts and things whatsoever concerning the Premises as fully and in every respect as I myself might or could do were I personally present at the doing thereof and attorneys one or more under him for the purpose aforesaid to and again at his pleasure to revoke. ratifying and confirming and by these presents allowing whatsoever my said attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents.
