I Stephen Vinny of of the county of Washington being very sick and weak in body but in perfect mind and memory thanks to God calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die to make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the ground to be buried in decent christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive them again by the almighty power of God and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it is pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form — First I give and bequeath to Elizabeth my dearly beloved wife all my lands Tenements goods and chattels to be left to her till the youngest child comes of age and then sold and equally divided among they boys only they part to get half of a boys part if said miscapity requires they land to be sold for to support they family she having her thirds out of the estate if after her decease they boys be put to such trades as suits themselves And where I likewise make constitute and Ordain they sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament all and singular my Lands and Tenements by her pecely to be possessed and enjoyed during her continuancecy and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills Legacies bequeath and Executors by me in any wise before now other to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifth day of May the twenty years of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four.
