Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Jamison of
Washington county in the State of Virginia, have for and in
consideration of the sum of Eight dollars current money of the
United States, bargained, sold, assigned over and transferred
to Andrew Russell of the county aforesaid, all the estate,
right, title interest, and demands which I have in a certain
Entry of Land with the Surveyor of Washington County aforesaid,
made and admitted by a Land Office bearing warrant
issued the 10th day of September 1796, designated by the
N^o 692 being an exchanged warrant issued in the name
of the said Andrew Russell, and the one hundred and
aforesaid assigned by him, to wit, which said Entry
together with the warrant in which the same is
thereby assigned over and transferred to the said Andrew
Russell his heirs and assigns forever. And I do further
by these presents constitute and appoint the said Andrew
Russell my irrevocable attorney with full power and
authority in my name and for his own benefit and
advantage to do act and perform in every respect as
fully and amply as I the said Thomas Jamison
might or could do were I personally present, and
I do hereby further authorize and empower the said Surveyor
of Washington county to make out the certificate of conveyance
in the name of the said Andrew Russell in the same
manner as if the Entry aforesaid had been admitted
and made in the name of the said Andrew Russell.

 of Washington county for and in consideration of the sum of
 sixty dollars current money of the United States, here
 bargained and sold and do hereby assign and transfer to
 Andrew Russell all the right which I have acquired
 to a certain tract or parcel of Land in Washington county
 by an Entry with the Surveyor of the said county which
 is in the words following to wit. To wit. May 21st Joel
 Hallaird assigner of Robert Preston enters 200
 acres of Land by warrant in Washington county lying
 on the waters of the North fork joining the Land
 of Mr. Cummings bought of Carville, also John Moffatt
 and John M. Calloughs land to include all or some
 Land fit for cultivation in said bounds. And
 for the purposes of investing in the said Andrew
 Russell ^{this day or assigner} an indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee
 simple in the said Entry of Land I do hereby
 constitute and appoint the said Andrew Russell
 my lawful attorney with full power and authority
