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present in my possession To have & to hold all and singular the said goods household stuff furniture and other the premises above hereinbefore and sold or mentioned or intended to be to the said Thomas Edmiston his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever. And I the said William Edmiston for myself my heirs executors & administrators sell and singular the said goods & personal estate unto the said Thomas Edmiston his heirs executors administrators or assigns against me my heirs executors & administrators & against all and every other persons will warrant and defend. And witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty first day of September in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.
