It being for a bond said Galloway hath against said me for forty pounds which property I do warn and defend to said Galloway from any person or persons laying any Just Claim Right or Title this nine day of June as Witness my hand and seal the said ninth day of June 1789

To two spinning Wheels at \$1.10. It being for a bond of One  
hundred and eleven <sup>ten shilling</sup> pound which said Bowen hath against me  
which properly I do warn and defend unto said Bowen from any  
parson or parsons laying any Just Colame wright or Tittle to the  
said property as Witness my hand and seal this ninth day of June  
1789
