Will of Westmoreland in Virginia being determined by Gods assistance
to pass the way to England and considering the uncertainty of this mortal
life although being in perfect health doe ordain this my last will and
Testament as followeth I commend my soul to the mercie of Christ my saviour
and my worldly estate to be disposed of as followeth I Inprimis to my loving
wife Rebecca Brunt I give and bequeath during her natural life the third
part of all my lands in the county of Westmoreland aforesaid together with my
best house upon them To my son Edmund Brunt I give and bequeath my
two plantations at Romney and to his heirs forever saving still out of them
unto his mother her third as aforesaid during her life, To my daughter
Katharine and to her heirs forever I give and bequeath my plantation of
three hundred Acres situate upon Aquia River at peace in the County
aforesaid saving throught the third thereof unto her mother during her
life as above said and of all my lease goods chattels and chattels in
Virginia and England my debts being first paid, I dispose as followeth
unto my loving wife Rebecca Brunt I give five fifteenths and to my son
Edmund Brunt I give six fifteenths and to my daughter Katharine Brunt
I give four fifteenths and in Case that either of my said children dye before
they come to age then I give the said dying childs part to the child surviving
and of this my last will and Testament I declare and appoint my above named
loving wife Rebecca Brunt my sole Executrix whom likewise I appoint
Guardian of my said children dated March the 26th 1658.
