god doe make constitute and ordain this my last will and Testament
Imprimis, I bequeath my soul to God that gave it and my body to the ground
from whence it came therein to be interred with solemn and decent
burial in such and certain hope of a happy resurrection both of Soul and
body together to Everlasting Glory.

I give Daniel Sisson the first foal of the bay mare, I leave mine whole estate
chattels chattels moveable immovable and servants and Land whatsoever unto
my loving wife Dorothy Baldridge to use and dispose thereof as she shall
please and think fit and requisite ordaining her my full and whole Executor
of this my last will and Testament attally renouncing and revoking all former
wills whatsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this 26th of November 1650.
