of this my last will and Testament attally renouncing and Revoking all former
wills whatsoever In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this 26th of November 1650.

Will. { the County of Westmoreland and Colony of Virginia being sick
and weak of body but of sound and perfect memory praised be god and
knowing the certainty of death and the time and however uncertain doe
therefore make and declare this to be my last will and Testament revoking
and Annulling all former wills and Testaments by me made and
ordaining this to stand for and as my last will and Testament.
Imprimis I bequeath my soul into the hands of God almighty
hoping through the merits of Jesus Christ his only son and my

alone survivor to receive remission of all my sins, and I commit my body to the earth
from whence it came to be buried according to the direction of my Executors here
after mentioned And as touching such worldly estate as God hath bestowed upon
me withall I do dispose thereof as followeth.

First I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Anne Armesby the one half or moiety
of all my whole estate both of land & chattels both moveable and immovable of
what nature or Quality soever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my loving daughter Anne Armesby the other half or
moiety of my whole estate equally to be divided between my said wife and daughter
not one share of either to exceed the other in any part of my whole estate and
further my will is that my said daughter Anne Armesby shall be and remain
with my said wife her mother until she shall attain to the age of sixteen
Years or be married and that (in the mean time) my whole estate remain
together with my said daughter ~~and~~ under the keeping governing and ordering
of my said wife; And that the one half of my whole estate be delivered to my
said daughter at her day of marriage or at the full age of sixteen Years further
if in Case it shall so happen that my said wife marry before my said daughter
comes to the age of sixteen Years or be married that then the husband of my
said wife shall put in security for the delivering of the one half of my whole
estate unto my said daughter as aforesaid and that her estate for behoove of hers
and after the decease of my said wife Anne Armesby I give and bequeath
all my lands with all edifices and appurtenances therunto belonging unto my said
daughter Anne Armesby And I do hereby nominate and appoint my said loving wife
Anne Armesby ~~to be~~ my whole and sole executrix of this my last will and Testament.
