Will 3 parsh in the county of Westmorland planter being now
sick bed of god and perfect memory do make constitute and ordain this
my last will and Testament in manner and form following Imprimis
I give and bequeath unto my son John Payne and his heirs my share
of the four hundred Acre of land which is between Cornelius Morphew
and me also a cow Called Trotell and a Gun wher he comes to the age of
twenty one Years, likewise my will is that he work for his mother
till he be seventeen Years of age, in Case he die before he comes to
age the land to fall to the next heir, I give and bequeath unto my
daughter Elizabeth one Yearling, I Tame I give and bequeath unto
my loving wife Millicent Payne my share of hogs that are be-
tween Cornelius Morphew and me with all the rest of my
estate, I give and bequeath unto my son James one two year
old hifa with her increase.

lastly I do constitute ordain and make Millicent Payne my loving wife
sole and whole Executrix of this my last will and Testament affixed my
hand and seal this 9th of December 1668.

To I know all men by these presents that I William
Lord Hunfield son and heir of Captain Robert Hunfield
of Salem in New England and Captain Richard Moore of the aforesaid
place Guardian of the aforesaid William Hunfield for the Valuable
consideration of six thousand pound of Tobacco in hand by me the
said William Hunfield of Captain John Lord receives have alienated
and sold and doe hereby alien and sell from me the said William
Hunfield my heirs executors unto Captain John Lord
