clothes and as for the rest of my estate, I doe fully give and
bequeath unto my wellbeloved son in law, all my land that
is mine or belonging to me, with the rest of my estate movably

and immovably, with what land is mine or belonging to me I do freely give unto
my wellbelov'd son in law Thomas Sampkins; it is my desire also that the
said Child should be brought up to read the bible and to writing for its my
desire that he may be brought up to knowledge and to have the fear of
God which charge I trust my Amour will not be unminisfull to be
done; it is my will that as for the land it may be planted or sowed
provided that they make an Orchard upon the said land or that they
pay a Yearly rent towards the maintaining of the said Cephau and Hoping
that these and every of these above writt'n and mentioned in this my last
will and Testament will be accomplished and doe hereby revoke and annul
all other wills and doe hereby confirm this to be my last will and
