In the name of God amen I Trage Olathman of the county of Westmoreland doe make this my last will & Testament as followeth Vize I give unto Walter English's children and unto Thomas Collins otherwise Thomas Attwells children my whole estate to be equally divided between Walter English and Thomas Attwells Children my personal estate —

3^{rdly} I give unto Daniel and Honr Silivant all my land that I bought of Col^d Spencers equally to be divided between them two that is to say Daniel and Honr. my share which is the one half where the house now stands As Witnefs my hand and seal this 20th of December 1668.
