debts are paid, I doe give and bequeath unto John Moore
one heifer - I doe give and bequeath unto my dear wife,
Frances Dodson, the third part of my estate, and that she
shall be possessed with my sole and entire estate of lands
and all other things both movable and unmovable until
my son Thomas Dodson doth come to the age of twenty
one Years - I then I give and bequeath unto my loving
son Thomas Dodson all the rest of my estate both real
and personal, either of lands, goods, chatties and with what
else some is mine, either in Virginia or elsewhere to be
possessed with the same when he shall come to the full

age of one and twenty years likewise I do make and ordain my true and loving
wife Frances my whole and sole Exor. of this my last will and Testament
and do utterly renounce and relinquish all former and other wills wh
- soever As Witness my hand and seal this 17th of October 1668.
